
Here is a prayer for this week:

Try this fun craft idea:



Be ready for Jesus - Make a unique Advent Calendar which looks out for God's blessings one day at a time.

You will need:

Coloured paper

scissors

glue

card

Christmas stickers

Marker pen

Cut out a green triangle to make a tree and stick it on a sheet of paper. Add a small rectangle of brown to make the trunk. Cut out 24 squares of paper in different colours and arrange them underneath. Number them 1-24 to make a calendar. Mount your picture on a piece of card. You could make two holes at the top and thread a

piece of ribbon through so that you can hang it up.

Now, everyday "Count your blessings" and think about something that you could thank God for and either stick one of your Christmas stickers on the tree or draw a picture and stick that on.
