

The Cheadle Comfort & Joy QR Christmas Trail

December 12th to 24th

Go on our trail around Cheadle to find the different Christmas displays (and see how many other Christmas windows you find on your way!) Look for the clues to help you find out what Christmas is really all about. There are 10 places for you to visit and at 3 of them you'll find special clues to help you work out what Christmas is about. If you find them all and solve the puzzle, come along to one of the All Hallows Christingle services on Christmas Eve, tell us the answer and win a prize!

Are you ready to find out what Christmas is really all about? Scan the QR code below then take a look at the list of places to visit on the other side of the sheet and decide where you're going to start. You'll find a special trail sheet at each place on the trail. At 3 places you'll find one of the clues you need and at the others you'll find a character from the Christmas story and a free activity for you to scan and download.

Ready to start searching for the real meaning of Christmas...?

The trail includes one school, two churches and a nursery plus six houses in the local area. All the Christmas displays will be visible from the pavement outside each location and you should be able to see a laminated trail sheet at each place. If one is missing, please let us know by texting 'missing sheet' and the address to 07907 384 371. You can visit them in any order—please follow social distancing guidelines and stay safe whilst having fun.

Visit Ladybridge School and look on their fencing for their Christmas display.

Visit 74 Boundary Road, look up to see the window & look on the tree to find the trail sheet.

Visit 64 Boundary Road and look on the wall to find the trail sheet.

Visit 64 St David's Road and look up to see the Christmas window

Visit 233 Stockport Road

Visit 29 Councillor Lane and look on the gates to see the trail sheet

Visit the Old School Nursery and look on their fencing for their Christmas display.

Visit 17 Dryden Avenue and look on the fence to see the trail sheet.

Visit St Cuthbert's Church (look at Stockport Rd) and look on the notice board to see the trail sheet.

Visit All Hallows Church (222 Councillor Lane) and look on the wall to see the trail sheet.
