

Christ the King open for services Beginning Sunday 6th September.

To open we must follow the Government regulations and the Church of England guidelines.

How is the church prepared?

- The collection plate will be on the right near the door. Please drop your collection in.
- There will be two stations for you to sanitise your hands and your name will be checked on a list.
- A “steward” will direct you to your place.
- Chairs will be socially distanced in groups for households/bubbles, singly if you come on your own. Please do not move the chairs at any time.
- The weekly Notices will be on your seat.
- The Order of Service will be shown on the screen. We aren't allowed to sing hymns.

What must I do before I come?

- You need to tell us you are coming. Let us know no later than **6pm on the Friday before.**

If you need to use the toilet

- Ladies are asked to use the Gents where there are two cubicles. Gents are asked to use the Disabled toilet.
- The Ladies is reserved for the preschool.

What must I do in church?

- Wear a face mask at all times.
- Observe social distancing.
You may need to queue to come in.
- Don't stop to talk to people once I'm inside the building.
- Sanitise my hands.
- Follow the directions of the "stewards."
- If I come with children I'll make sure they stay with me and don't run around.

- We must not sing hymns but we will play music.
Please don't sing along.
- Wait to be invited to go up for communion.
The words of distribution will be said once by the priest at the altar.
- Walk up the centre aisle.
The wafer will be dropped into your hand.
If you wish you may carry it back to your seat to consume.
You may lower your mask while you eat the wafer.
- Return to my seat by the side aisle nearest my seat.

- At the end of the service wait until a "steward" invites me to leave.
- Do not stop to talk inside the building.
- Move away from the door so others may come out safely.
- You are welcome to talk to others in the car park but please remember social distancing.
