The Apostles' Creed

Acclamations

The Lord God almighty is our Father: **he loves us and tenderly cares for us.** The Lord Jesus Christ is our Saviour: **he has redeemed us and will defend us to the end.** The Lord, the Holy Spirit, is among us: **he will lead us in God's holy way.** 

To God almighty, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, be praise and glory today and for ever. Amen.
