We share the peace in our usual way with those of our own household and a wave or British Sign language peace to others.

This is a good time to use sanitiser if you are receiving communion.

SHARING IN COMMUNION

The Lord be with you **and also with you.**

Lift up your hearts. **We lift them to the Lord.**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to give thanks and praise.

We praise God for his mighty acts ending with ... for ever praising you and saying:

Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory.

Hosanna in the highest.

We recall the Last Supper ending... Great is the mystery of faith:

Christ has died: Christ is risen: Christ will come again.

We offer ourselves, ending ... in songs of everlasting praise:

Blessing and honour and glory and power be yours for ever and ever. Amen.

THE LORD'S PRAYER... As our Saviour taught us, so we pray:

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven.

Give us today our daily bread.

Forgive us our sins
