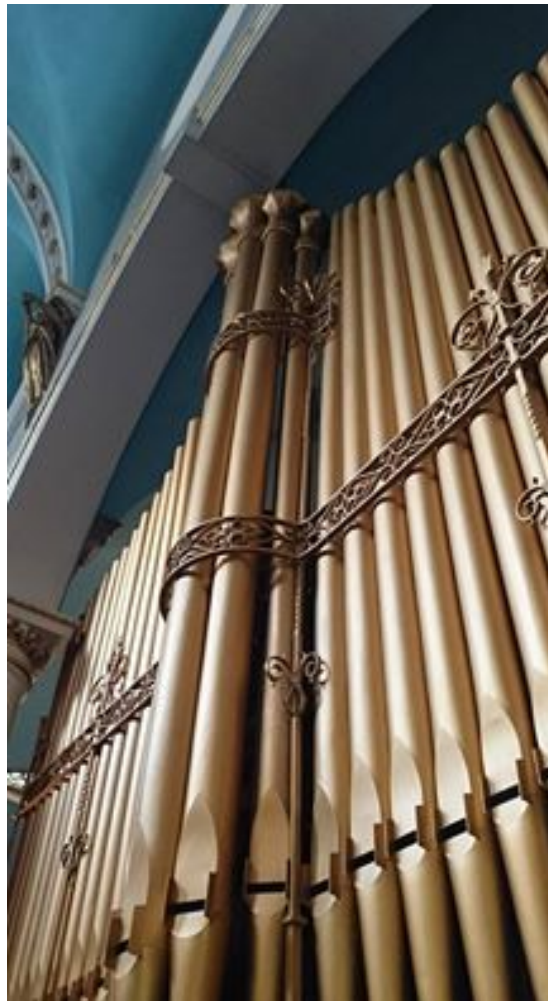


# **ORGAN MUSIC FROM ST MICHAEL'S CORNHILL, City of London**

The audience is invited to join each recital from 12.45pm on Zoom. At 1.00pm the music will be presented by the day's recitalist in discussion with Jonathan Rennert, and at the end there will be an opportunity for members of the audience to comment and ask questions. The music, on You Tube, will have been especially recorded on the historic organ of St Michael's, without an audience in the church. The intention of this format is to reproduce something of the feeling of a normal recital, at which members of the audience can see one another and speak to the recitalist.
