- **Arranging tables and chairs** for our Bring and Share lunch. If you are able to arrive early on Sunday and help, that would be great!
- We hope that you will be able to join us on Sunday for our Harvest Praise, our Bring and Share Lunch, Tea Time Service or all! If you are able to **contribute food**, we would be very grateful.
