

# Welcome Back!

We are now in the 4<sup>th</sup> stage of the road map and most legal restrictions regarding Covid have been lifted, but the underlying assumption is that we all take responsibility for our own actions in order to protect others. At All Saints' we are easing into new arrangements and request your co-operation in following these recommendations.

- 1) Please register your attendance at church using the QR code and capturing it with your mobile phone using the NHS Covid app. If you do not have a mobile or the app, please sign in on the Test and Trace sheet placed on the font.
- 2) Please use the hand sanitiser provided on entering and leaving the church.
- 3) It is recommended that face coverings are used in the church. This includes when singing. Wearing a mask is particularly important in confined spaces, e.g. the parish room and the vestry.
- 4) If you are given hymn books and prayer books by the sidesmen on entering, on leaving please place in the green box provided at the back of the church.
- 5) Please bear in mind social distancing and respect other peoples' desire for a safe space.
- 6) Adhere to advice from the clergy, churchwardens and sidesmen, who may instigate additional safety processes where needed, e.g. at busy times to reduce congestion.
- 7) For those who would prefer more formal social distancing arrangements, the pews beneath the bell will remain marked out to provide two metre social distancing.
