Wednesdays 21st February – 20th March, 2.00pm at Berinsfield Church

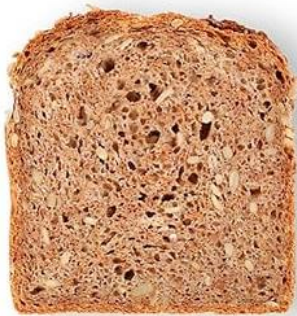
