HOLY WEEK

Palm Sunday

8am Said Eucharist

10am Parish Eucharist with Palm Procession
Meet at Parkfield Medical Centre car park.

5pm Evensong

Holy Monday - Wednesday

10am Eucharist
A commemoration of the Lord's Supper, and the centre of our Christian Faith, with short addresses.

8pm Compline with Address
The final monastic Office of the day, a short meditative service, where we give thanks to God for the day passed and ask for his protection as we journey into night.

In addition, there will be a time of Silent Prayer on Tuesday at 12 noon.

THE TRIDUUM

Maundy Thursday

11am Chrism Eucharist at St Albans Cathedral

All are welcome to attend this Eucharist with the bishops, clergy and lay ministers of the diocese where oils are blessed for the coming year. There can be assistance with travel to St Albans.

8pm Liturgy of Maundy Thursday
followed by the Watch

This moving liturgy includes the washing of feet and the stripping of the Altar. We then join in silent prayer before the Blessed Sacrament at the Altar of Repose until 10:30pm.

Good Friday

10.45am Churches Together Walk of Witness

We gather at St Mary's and walk to the War Memorial for a short ecumenical service at 11am

12:30pm Stations of the Cross

This service of prayer, reflection, and Bible readings walks with Jesus along the way of the Cross.

1:30pm Good Friday Liturgy

Christ is crucified and we hear readings, psalms and Scripture.

7pm 'The Saviour' by William Lloyd Webber at the
United Reformed Church, Darkes Lane

A performance of this little known work by the Good Friday Choir, which includes several St Mary's members

8pm Easter Vigil and First Mass of the Resurrection

This extraordinary liturgy tells the story of salvation in words from the Bible, interspersed with Psalmody.

We hear the sung proclamation of Easter, and we celebrate the triumph of Love in the sacrament of the Eucharist.
