MEET THE ARTIST IN THEIR WORKING STUDIO

Since our very first event 25 years ago, our Summer Art
Weeks has evolved organically to include group events
and pop-up exhibitions in private homes and gardens, as well
as at various public spaces. This year we want to celebratethe original
premise behind Warwickshire Open Studios where, for a short period each year, artists and makers
open their studios and invite art lovers into their world. This is your chance to see behind the
scenes and really understand how the art comes to life.

Where the magic happens...

Whether it's in a converted garage, a purpose-built garden studio or a commercial space, a working studio gives you a glimpse of the artistic processes and specialist equipment involved. Most of our artists will be working on new pieces during Summer Art Weeks. Seeing them in action will give you a deeper appreciation of the time, skill, and patience required to arrive at a finished product – from raw materials to finished artwork.

Visiting working studios also provides a fascinating insight into artists' creative spaces, from paint and clay splattered floors to wood shavings everywhere. What's more, artists love to chat about their work and their inspirations; and in this environment they can show as well as tell!



OUR 2025 BURSARY WINNERS

This year, we are once again delighted to support a diverse range of emerging artists with our Emerge Bursary Scheme. We welcomed applications from talented artists aged 18 and above, working in any art medium and who have never participated in WOS Summer Art Weeks before. Our bursary is to help emerging artists to get involved in Summer Art Weeks and assist in their transition to becoming an established artist. Many of our previous bursary winners have now become established artists, who now show and sell their work far and wide.

Our winners were given free Summer Art Week's registration and entry, help in finding a venue and £250 in cash. In addition, they received mentoring support from an established artist to help them prepare for the event. The winners:



Clara Moss (textile artist at venue 37 & 40)

Clara recently left a job in the corporate world to pursue a full-time career as a textile artist. She focuses on dyeing fabrics and wools to create stitched creations, influenced by the natural world. Her ambition is to set up a creative hub where she can share her working processes with other like-minded individuals by leading workshops, and by establishing a community in which she can pass on her skills and learn from others



Eve Beazley (multi-disciplinary artist at venue 114)

Eve uses a range of techniques to communicate the stories that exist in and on her body. Through mixed media and layering techniques she creates groups of images that communicate multiple ideas about herself. They are not identical, but have connections – they form a group, a community. Together they start to tell Eve's story. By exploring her creative practice through a feminist lens, with each artwork completed she finds out more about herself, her body, and practice.



Katherine Taylor (ceramicist at venue 63)

With a background of over 20 years working in the NHS, Katherine's journey into pottery began at a psychiatric hospital where she worked, and which had a pottery studio and kiln. She was struck by the therapeutic impact that working with clay had on the patients and fell in love with the medium herself. Katherine hand-builds ceramic vessels that embrace imperfection; she enhances texture and narrative to shape each piece, and alters its form to give it a more organic feel.



Zélie Swan (painter at venue107)

With a background in nursing and other health-related fields, Zélie always found the time for creativity. Following a period of ill-health, she started painting and fell in love, primarily focusing on portraits. Zélie approaches each piece with curiosity, trying to capture the subject's likeness and also create something beautiful. Painting to her is not just about the final piece, but the joy of the journey, and how therapuetic the process of bringing a vision to life can be!




