As we sit quietly before this service commences let us prepare ourselves to meet Jesus and receive him into our hearts by spending a few moments in prayer and reflection.

WELCOME

Please stand as we sing our first Hymn.

OPENING HYMN: O WORSHIP THE LORD (SOF 457)

1. O WORSHIP THE LORD in the beauty of holiness.

Bow down before Him, His glory proclaim; With gold of obedience and incense of lowliness, Kneel and adore Him: the Lord is His name.

- 2. Low at His feet lay thy burden of carefulness, High on His heart He will bear it for thee. Comfort thy sorrows, and answer thy prayerfulness, Guiding thy steps as may best for thee be.

Truth in its beauty, and love in its tenderness, These are the offerings to lay on His shrine.

He will accept for the name that is dear: Mornings of joy give for evenings of tearfulness, Trust for our trembling, and hope for our fear.

5. O worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness, Bow down before Him, His glory proclaim; With gold of obedience and incense of lowliness. Kneel and adore Him: the Lord is His name.

For when we behave just as we wish, without thinking of you: Father, forgive us:

Save us and help us.

For failing you by what we do, and think and say:
Father, forgive us:

May the God of love bring you back to himself, forgive you your sins, and assure you of his eternal love in Jesus Christ our Lord.

GLORIA IN EXCELSIS

Please stand as we say together:

Glory to God in the highest, and peace to his people on earth.

Lord God, heavenly King, almighty God and Father, we worship you, we give you thanks, we praise you for your glory.

Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of the Father, Lord God, Lamb of God, you take away the sin of the world: have mercy on us;

THE COLLECT FOR THE DAY

Creator God, you made us all in your image: may we discern you in all that we see, and serve you in all that we do; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

For when we let ourselves be drawn away from you by temptations in the world:

Father, forgive us:

For when we live as if we were ashamed to belong to your son; Father, forgive us:

you are seated at the right hand of the Father: receive our prayer.

For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

We sit for our first reading:

COLOSSIANS 2:6-15

As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, continue to walk in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.

Watch out that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental principles of the world, and not according to Christ. For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, and you have come to fullness in him, who is the head of every ruler and authority. In him also you

were circumcised with a spiritual circumcision, by the removal of the body of the flesh in the circumcision of Christ; when you were buried with him in baptism, you were also raised with him through faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead. And when you were dead in trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive together with him, when he forgave us all our trespasses, erasing the record that stood against us with its legal demands. He set this aside, nailing it to the cross. He disarmed the rulers and authorities and made a public example of them, triumphing over them in it.

CANTICLE: PSALM 138

Please say the words in bold:

1 I give you thanks, O Lord, with my whole heart:

before the gods I sing your praise:

2 I bow down toward your holy temple and give thanks to your name for your steadfast love and your faithfulness,

for you have exalted your name and your word

above everything.

3 On the day I called, you answered me;
you increased my strength of soul.
4 All the kings of the earth shall praise you, O Lord.

for they have heard the words of your mouth.

8 The Lord will fulfill his purpose for me; your steadfast love, O Lord, endures forever.

Do not forsake the work of your hands.

We sit for our second reading:

GOSPEL READING: LUKE 11, 1-13

Jesus was praying in a certain place, and after he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples." So he said to them, "When you pray, say: Father, may your name be revered as holy.

May your kingdom come.

Give us each day our daily bread.

And forgive us our sins.

for we ourselves forgive everyone indebted to us.

And do not bring us to the time of trial."

And he said to them, "Suppose one of you has a friend, and you go to him at midnight and say to him, 'Friend, lend me three loaves of bread, for a friend of mine has arrived, and I have nothing to set before him.' And he answers from within, 'Do not bother me; the door has already been locked, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot get up and give you anything.' I tell you, even though he will not get up and give him anything out of friendship, at least because of his persistence he will get up and give him whatever he needs.

"So I say to you, Ask, and it will be given to you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened for you. For everyone who asks receives, and everyone who searches finds, and for everyone who knocks, the door will be opened. Is there anyone among you who, if your child asked for a fish, would give a snake instead of a fish? Or if the child asked for an egg, would give a scorpion? If you, then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

TAX CERTIFICATES

If you are a French taxpayer, you will receive an annual 'tax certificate' for your giving online, by bank transfer or cheque which will allow you to claim a reduction on your tax (*)

*up to a limit for all your charitable giving of 20% of your taxable income
