
Generous God,

REFLECTIONS..... MARIAN IVENS

Back in 2020 I was very ill in hospital. When I was not just managing the pain I prayed, though mostly, I speechlessly, "just hung in there." It was not easy to be articulate, to pray in words or to converse, but I was blessed with pictures.

Several Christmases ago I was sent this slim card with the name of Jesus written down its length. There was something that made me keep that card and in hospital I was able to ask myself why?



My question led to a frank conversation with Jesus. I confessed that I did not have any problems with God as Father and the Holy Spirit as a spiritual companion, and even with Jesus when he walked on earth, but there was something that I did not "get" regarding the status of Jesus now.

It was, as Colossians 3 verse 1 says, "If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of the Father." That was "the bit" I had not got! My head, maybe, but not my heart. I find this "head/heart" thing quite a challenge if I am honest!

I believe it was because I was so vulnerable in my illness and my intellect was exhausted, that the truth could bypass my intellect, and I really "got it!" I could not over think it. God in His mercy showed me in a picture, that was more than a picture, Jesus at the right hand of God, as He is NOW, interceding for us, for me. And, against the odds, I recovered. As the hymn goes, "Only by Grace can we enter," and that, only by the blood of Jesus, his death and resurrection; "For you have died and your life is hid with Christ in God." Colossians 3 v.3

Dear Church Friends, we are more precious to God than our intellect, hearts and bodies can imagine! His Grace is unfathomable.


