

Gathering to worship God

Greeting

All: Lord, direct our thoughts, and teach us to pray. Lift up our hearts to worship you in spirit and in truth, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Saying sorry to God

Confession

God our Father,
we come to you in sorrow for our sins.
For turning away from you,
and ignoring your will for our lives;
Father, forgive us:

All: save us and help us.

For behaving just as we wish, without thinking of you; Father, forgive us:

All: save us and help us.

For failing you by what we do and think and say;
Father, forgive us:

All: save us and help us.

For letting ourselves be drawn away from you

by temptations in the world about us; Father, forgive us:

All: save us and help us.

For living as if we were ashamed to belong to your Son;
Father, forgive us:

All: save us and help us.

The Presider says the words of forgiveness.

Almighty God, who is all forgiveness, ave mercy upon you, pardon and deliver you from all your sins, confirm and strengthen you in all goodness, and keep you in life eternal, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

The prayer of the day is said.

The Collect: Prayer of the Day

God of glory, the end of our searching, help us to lay aside all that prevents us from seeking your kingdom, and to give all that we have to gain the pearl beyond all price, through our Saviour Jesus Christ.

The Presider introduces a period of silent prayer with the words,

'Let us pray.'

Creator God, you made us all in your image: may we discern you in all that we see, and serve you in all that we do; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Hearing and Responding to the Word of God

We listen to the reading(s)

First Reading: Proverbs 25.6-7

Do not put yourself forward in the king's presence or stand in the place of the great,

for it is better to be told, 'Come up here,' than to be put lower in the presence of a noble.

This is the word of the Lord.

All: Thanks be to God.

Second Reading: Hebrews 13.1-8, 15-16

Let mutual affection continue. Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by doing that some have entertained angels without knowing it.

Remember those who are in prison, as though you were in prison with them, those who are being tortured, as though you yourselves were being tortured.

Let marriage be held in honour by all, and let the marriage bed be kept undefiled, for God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterers.

Keep your lives free from the love of money, and be content with what you have, for he himself has said, 'I will never leave you or forsake you.' So we can say with confidence,

"The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can anyone do to me?" Remember your leaders, those who spoke the word of God to you; consider the outcome of their way of life, and imitate their faith.

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

Through him, then, let us continually offer a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that confess his name. Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God.

This is the word of the Lord.

All: Thanks be to God.

Then we stand with the Presider for the Gospel reading

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke.

All: Glory to you, O Lord

Gospel Reading: Luke 14.1, 7-14

On one occasion when Jesus] was going to the house of a leader of the Pharisees to eat a meal on the Sabbath, they were watching him closely.

When he noticed how the guests chose the places of honour, he told them a parable.

'When you are invited by someone to a wedding banquet, do not sit down at the place of honour, in case someone more distinguished than you has been invited by your host, and the host who invited both of you may come and say to you, 'Give this person your place,' and then in disgrace you would start to take the lowest place.

'But when you are invited, go and sit down at the lowest place, so that when your host comes, he may say to you, 'Friend, move up higher'; then you will be honoured in the presence of all who sit at the table with you. For all who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.'

He said also to the one who had invited him,

"When you give a luncheon or a dinner, do not invite your friends or your brothers and sisters or your relatives or rich neighbours, in case they may invite you in return, and you would be repaid. But when you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, and the blind. And you will be blessed because they cannot repay you, for you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous."

At the end of the Gospel reading

This is the Gospel of the Lord.

All: Thanks be to God.

You send your Spirit to bring new life to the world and clothe us with power from on high. And so we join the angels to celebrate and say:

Pour your Spirit on us that we may love one another, work for the healing of the earth, and share the good news of Jesus, as we wait for his coming in glory.
