The new Alpha Youth Series is being made with and for this generation, weaving in their priorities, challenges, and questions. The 10-session series introduces and explores the core ideas of the Christian faith, in a relevant, accessible, and engaging way. Each session is designed to spark open

conversations where young people feel excited, safe, and empowered to engage with the big questions of life, faith and purpose.

Alpha Youth is a global initiative spanning across continents and languages, reaching into churches, youth groups, schools, cafes, and homes worldwide. Our aim is to develop a new series that resonates universally, empowering young people from all walks of life to confidently invite their friends, regardless of their country, context or background.



OVERVIEW OF SESSIONS



SESSION 1: WELCOME TO THE CONVERSATION In this session, we invite you to join us on the journey of the Alpha Youth Series! Session 1 helps create the space to ask life's big questions around purpose and explore what truly matters.

ALPHA YOUTH DAY SESSION 6: WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT? The Holy Spirit and what the Holy Spirit could do in our lives.

Sessions 6 and 7 are run together as part of a fun and unforgettable day.

SESSION 2: JESUS IS...? This session will explore who Jesus was and is – through history, His teachings, and His goodness.

ALPHA YOUTH DAY SESSION 7: HOW CAN I BE FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT? This session builds on session 6 and looks at how we experience the Holy Spirit, and the gifts of the Spirit. The end of the session gives an opportunity to encounter the Holy Spirit.

SESSION 3: WHAT DOES REAL LOVE LOOK LIKE? A look at the meaning of real, unconditional, sacrificial love, exploring sin, forgiveness, and God's amazing grace.

SESSION 8: HOW DOES GOD HELP US OVERCOME EVIL? Here, we discuss what evil is, where we see it in the world, and what the Bible says we can do to face it and overcome it.

SESSION 4:
WHY WOULD I WANT A
RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD?

From everyday friendships to a relationship with God – in this session we explore what it means to be invited into a relationship with God and how it changes and transforms us.

SESSION 9: DOES GOD HEAL TODAY? In this session, we look at what healing is, how we play our part, and explore how healing is presented in the Bible.

SESSION 5: WHAT DOES A RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD LOOK LIKE? In this session, we build on session 4 and explore the practical and the personal ways we can grow in our relationship with God such as prayer, the Bible and worship.

SESSION 10: WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

The final session in the series looks at the Church, community and what's next after Alpha. This isn't the end; Alpha Youth is just the start.

JESSE FELLINGHAM, OX POPS


Jesse lives in London, he is calm collected, with a presence that is felt in any room he is in. A bass and keys player, Jesse has a heart of worship, and he is humble, personable, eloquent and smart. He feels comfortable talking to any age group and loves evangelism - you will find him approaching strangers and asking them guestions related to life, faith, and God on "The Way UK". Jesse aims to be a good role-model to the younger people around him. He's been our man-on-the-ground as our Vox Pops correspondent. He's interviewed hundreds of people in cities around the world, from all walks of life, to get their views on topics around life, faith, meaning and purpose.

For the first time we have a Vox Pops Correspondent who has gone around the world asking young people from all backgrounds questions about life, faith and purpose.

"Vox Pop" street interviews provide levity, humour and moments of empathy. They model a variety of answers to a topic from a diverse range of perspectives, Christian and non-Christian. Most importantly they provide an entry point to the group discussion.

While the content has been designed to be accessible for a non-Christian young person, there are some ideas that can seem strange and even heavy. Vox Pops are great way to break this intensity. The first Vox Pop of an episode tends to be an icebreaker to help settle the group into an episode, while others ask questions around the topics in the session.

Vox pops have the non-Christian guest in mind. The responses aim to cover what everyone thinks on a particular subject including the Christian answer. This allows us to 'say out loud' what everyone is thinking in the room, get them thinking more on their view, and give the group the best chance to have an open and honest discussion.





REGISTER

MyAlpha is a free resource to support you through your entire Alpha experience. Access the learning centre, series videos, training videos, and promotional materials <u>here</u>.

TRAIN YOUR TEAM

The things that can most affect the success of any Alpha is training your Alpha team. You can find all the training videos and guides in <u>MyAlpha</u>.

DOWNLOAD THE VIDEOS

Download the videos for free.

INVITE

Invitations are vital in spreading the news about your Alpha. Encourage your church and wider community to get on board and invite their friends.

PRAY

Alpha is reliant on the Holy Spirit and prayer is vital to the effectiveness of Alpha. Some suggestions include getting your whole church praying in your Sunday services and small groups, getting people together to pray before each session, and getting hosts and helpers praying for each guest by name throughout Alpha.

RUN

Start running your Alpha! You might want to consider hosting an informal "launch party". This makes it even easier to invite guests along to hear about Alpha and what it involves. Alpha can be run in-person, or online.

SAFEGUARDING

When running Alpha specifically for youth or young people, it is crucial to prioritise the safety and well-being of young people. In addition to following general safeguarding practices, which includes training hosts and helpers and following safer recruitment processes, it is important to create an atmosphere where young participants feel comfortable and empowered to express themselves. This will involve appointing youth leaders who understand the unique challenges faced by young people and can provide appropriate support or, in the case of an Alpha being hosted by youth or young people themselves, ensuring that a suitable adult or youth leader is present to help supervise and facilitate a safe environment.

Additionally, it is essential to be willing to address topics relevant to youth that may come up, such as mental health,

peer pressure, and healthy relationships within the context of faith. By catering to the specific needs of young participants, we can create a nurturing environment that encourages their spiritual growth and development.

In conclusion, good safeguarding practices enable us to both create a safe environment and to recognize the signs that could indicate harm or abuse and to know how to respond whenever a concern arises. Consistent with the best practices, including Alpha International's safeguarding statement we strongly recommend that churches and organisations running Alpha should have appropriate and legally compliant safeguarding policies and procedures in place, which are well understood by all involved, so that team members, volunteers and participants experience a safe environment.

FAQS

Is the Alpha Youth Series free?

Yes, thanks to our generous donors, the Alpha Youth Series is free to stream or download from MyAlpha.

Who is the Alpha Youth Series for?

The Alpha Youth Series is created for young people aged 13-17 who have never heard the Christian basics before.

How is the new Alpha Youth Series different from the previous 2017 version?

The new Alpha Youth Series has fewer episodes and is run over a shorter period of 8 weeks. The episode videos are also shorter. The series is hosted by 8 international young hosts (Gen Z), with updated content that weaves in the changing priorities, social climate, and culture of this generation. This series is created by young people for young people.

Can I put the Alpha Youth Series on social media platform such as Instagram or YouTube?

No. Please do not post the series episodes onto any social media channels as the content is designed to be more effective in small group discussion. Sneak peeks of the episodes are available on our website and these can be used to engage potential guests.

Can I extract the testimonies from the Alpha Youth Series to be used for other purposes?

Please refrain from extracting any content from the Alpha Youth Series for any purposes. The series contains many resources that are under license and contract, which restrict their use to the agreed terms. You will find cuts of the testimonies on MyAlpha that you may use for promotional activities.

Can I still use the 2017 Alpha Youth Series?

You may continue to use the 2017 Alpha Youth Series until further notice. Each region and country offers different translations. You can find them in your MyAlpha account. Should you need the videos in any other language not found on MyAlpha, please reach out to your National Alpha Office.

I'm a teacher, can I run Alpha Youth for my students?

Yes. While it's possible for teachers to run Alpha Youth, the suitability of this approach varies across countries and schools. Factors such as local education policies and institutional culture play a significant role. It's crucial to assess the specific context and obtain necessary permissions before proceeding.

I'm a parent, can I run Alpha Youth for my children?

Absolutely, Alpha Youth can be facilitated by anyone who desires to create a supportive space for young people to explore their questions about life, faith and purpose. To foster a rich and diverse conversation, consider inviting a range of participants, including friends and peers, in addition to your own children.

Pm under 18, can I run Alpha Youth for my friends?

The new Alpha Youth Series has been specifically designed to empower young people to lead Alpha Youth for their peers. When running Alpha Youth, the safety and well-being of everyone involved is so important. In addition to following safeguarding practices and training resources, it's important to create an atmosphere where young people feel comfortable and able to express themselves. In order to run a course for your friends as a young person, it's important to have a responsible adult involved to help facilitate a safe environment. This could be a parent or a guardian, teacher, your youth leader or church pastor.

Does the new Alpha Youth Series come with a guest guide?

The current series only comes with a leaders' guide to assist the small group hosts in leading their small group.

Where can I access all the videos and promotional assets?

Aside from the 10 video episodes of the Alpha Youth Series, you will also receive 2 training videos, alongside 4 complementary training videos for running your best Alpha Youth in different contexts, 9 weekly briefing videos for small group hosts, a weekly discussion PDF, brand guidelines and marketing materials to promote your course. All these are available to download for free on your MyAlpha account.

Are the videos available on YouTube?

Alpha Youth Series is available for streaming and download on your MyAlpha account. Due to licences and copyright, the videos are not permitted on YouTube.

Who can run Alpha Youth?

Alpha Youth can be run by almost anyone! Church/ Youth leaders run it for their young people, young people in school run it for their friends, parents run it for their teenagers, or families run it together for their teenagers.

Can I create paid ads on social media to promote my Alpha Youth?


