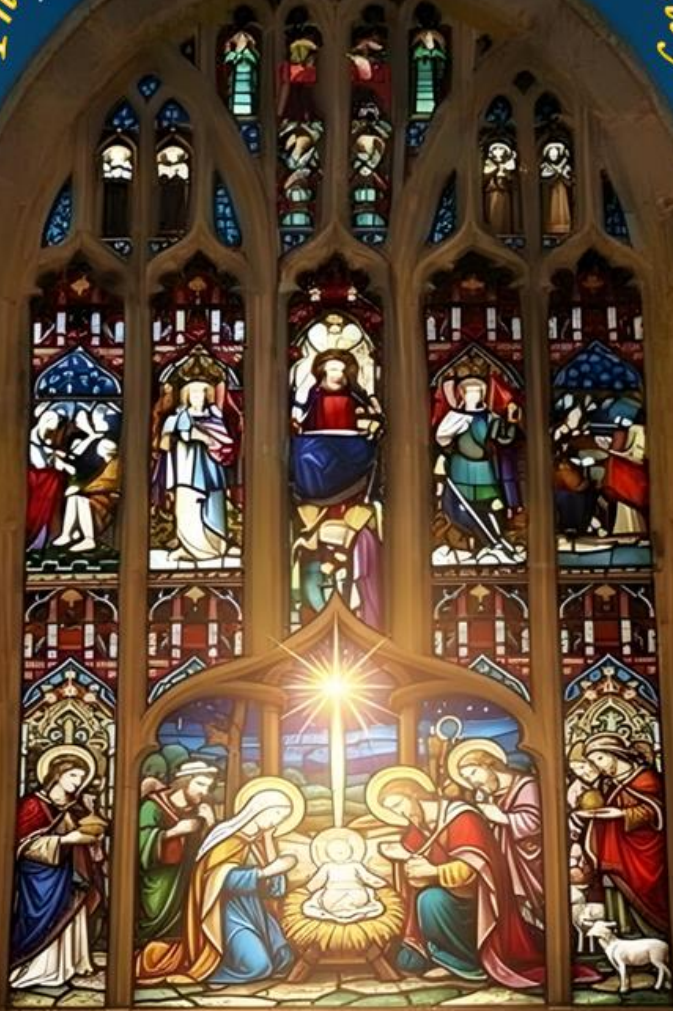


St Mary's Church & SNADS present:

Various passers-by are too busy or mean to help, on their way to the church for a grand unveiling of a new stained-glass window. Eventually one lady with two children stops, gives her some money, and invites her into the church.

Once inside she sees the image of the Nativity – a Tableau which comes to life as the lady tells the story of Jesus' birth.

This promenade production will take place in Sturminster Town Centre and St Mary's Church for (hopefully) 5 performances on Saturday 13th December. Rehearsals will be in late Oct onwards, once a week, on Wednesdays. It is a short piece with lots of small (and a few larger) parts, so not everyone will be needed every week.

Cast required: Adults and children for the "town" part plus the usual Nativity suspects (Wise men, shepherds, Mary & Joseph et al). And some carol singers....

Auditions are on Saturday 25th October at 11am in St Mary's Church Hall.
