Let's Celebrate! Romans 13 verse 14

This time of year there are parties, dinners; we put on our best clothes and we feel festive and special. To "put on," one dictionary defines as, to "adorn" oneself with clothing just like when we go partying! Likewise, when we become Christians, we "put on" Christ, like a garment, a party garment, for we have indeed, much to celebrate; life in all its fullness. From this moment, our goal in life is to become in practice, what we became in position, when we first believed; to become to those who see us what we are to God who sees us loved and celebrated. At Christmas we celebrate, "Emmanuel, God with us," now, and in this verse from Romans "put" also means now. We are to "put on the Lord Jesus" every day, not just for Christmas celebrations.

REST IN PEACE JUNE BOYILL


