REFLECTIONS.....REV. SARAH BICK

Is there something in your life you are waiting for or expecting? Are you waiting with longing, excitement, trepidation?

When you carefully read this gospel for the presentation of Christ in the temple in Luke Chap 2, you notice that it actually says slightly different things about Simeon and Anna, though we largely put them together and attribute to them the same qualities, gifts and feelings.

Simeon, it says, had the Holy Spirit resting upon him, and he was told that he would not see death until he had witnessed the Messiah - it doesn't actually say how old he was, we just imagine an old man because of the reference to death perhaps,, or because of what it says about Anna. Anna, it says, was old. 84 years old! That's not old I hear you cry! (Oh yes, it is! Oh no, it isn't!) And it says she was a prophet, and recognised Jesus when she saw him. But everyone, in theory at least, was waiting for the Messiah, so no doubt Anna was too, if only in that general sense.

So Anna and Simeon recognised the Messiah they were waiting for in the form of a baby. Anna at least must have realised that she would not see the fruition of God's plan. I'm sure Simeon was aware that the extent of the promise made to him had been fulfilled. Nevertheless, the recognition that the plan was afoot brought them both great joy

Last Sunday, the news was announced that we will at some point in the next few months will be moving to Cornwall. When I started my incumbency here in Mid-Wyedean, following on from my curacy here, I knew there were great challenges ahead. But I felt God's call to be here, and had confidence. We could face those challenges together. Many things have happened since, and not all things have worked out the way we expected or hoped. But God has been with us through these difficult times and there has been much joy. We have been brave in lots of things, and even led the way in some initiatives for the deanery and the diocese. The work here is clearly not complete, but God has never promised that it would be finished before we go (however frustrating that feels for me)!
