


SPIRITS *of the* DOLOMITES

In 1872, the popular English novelist Amelia B. Edwards embarked on an intrepid journey through the Dolomites. Her book, *Untrodden Peaks and Unfrequented Valleys*, first introduced the sublime beauty of the landscape to foreign travellers; now recognised as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

More than a century later, inspired by Edwards' travelogue, Susan and Alan Boyle retraced her route. In this spectacularly illustrated presentation, Alan juxtaposes Amelia's warm-hearted accounts of charming incidents on her journey with amusing anecdotes from his own research. The dual narratives reveal the enduring impact of Nature and humanity on our emotions.
