NOTICE OF ROADWORKS: TRAFFIC SIGNAL MODERNISATION at the junction of High Street and Church Lane

Starting week beginning 9 March, for 3 weeks approximately. Working hours will be Monday to Friday 8am to 4pm, with multi-way traffic lights in use at all times.

NB: Church Lane will be completely closed onto the High Street for 3 days from Wednesday 18 March to Friday 20 March – so vehicles wishing to exit Church Lane will need to proceed towards Grantchester Road and follow diversion signs via Grantchester.
