

Bourne Valley Good Friday Walk 3 April 2026

On this traditional **Good Friday Walk** we aim to link all the churches in our part of the Bourne Valley. We can enjoy the fellowship of the walk whilst reflecting on the story of Christ's Passion using a short liturgy based on the 'Last Words of Jesus on the Cross' to be held at each church. *Please bring your own packed lunch.*

Approximate timings are given below. We aim to finish at St Michael & All Angels Winterbourne Earls with hot cross buns and drinks at about 1730 (5.30pm).

Toilets are available at Newton Toney Village Memorial Hall, St Andrew's Boscombe, St Nicholas Porton (Church Room), Bourne Valley Methodist Church and St Michael & All Angels Winterbourne Earls.

Please keep **dogs** under strict control on the roads and near livestock.

There will be First Aiders on the walk.

There will be a "Back Marker" bringing up the rear of the walk who is First Aid trained
