If there is more than one psalm, the one we are using will be announced as part of the live stream.

When we reach the prayers we'll be using the Litany. You need to click on the blue words 'on page 400-403'

*Intercessions are offered*

¶ *for the Church and her life*

*Prayers may include the following concerns from the cycle on pages 364-365*

¶ *The persecuted Church*  
¶ *The oppressed peoples of the world*  
¶ *All who are lonely*  
¶ *All who are near to death*  
¶ *All who are facing loss*

*A form of prayer found on page 381 may be used.*

*The Litany on pages 400-403 may be said instead of the Prayers.*

*These responses may be used*

Lord, in your mercy

Lord, hear us.  
**Lord, graciously hear us.**

Let us pray.

God the Father,  
**All have mercy upon us.**

God the Son,  
**All have mercy upon us.**

God the Holy Spirit,  
**All have mercy upon us.**

Holy, blessed and glorious Trinity,  
**All have mercy upon us.**

**II**

From all evil and mischief;  
from pride, vanity and hypocrisy;  
from envy, hatred and malice;  
and from all evil intent,  
**All good Lord, deliver us.**

From sloth, worldliness and love of money;  
from hardness of heart  
and contempt for your word and your laws,  
**All good Lord, deliver us.**

From sins of body and mind;  
from the deceits of the world, the flesh and the devil,  
**All good Lord, deliver us.**

From famine and disaster;  
from violence, murder and dying unprepared,  
**All good Lord, deliver us.**

In all times of sorrow;  
in all times of joy;  
in the hour of death,  
and at the day of judgement,  
**All good Lord, deliver us.**

**III**

By the mystery of your holy incarnation;  
by your birth, childhood and obedience;  
by your baptism, fasting and temptation,  
**All good Lord, deliver us.**

There are 7 sections, and we will always use 1 and 7; the other sections will be announced each day.

To get back to the main Morning Prayer screen, click on the X at the top right hand corner.

The livestream will be on Christ Church's YouTube channel, and the recording will be there to watch later, the same as Sunday services.

If you would rather just listen and not bother with the app, that's fine! Alternatively, within the app is a recording of both Morning and Evening Prayer (but not Night Prayer) and you might prefer to listen to that.
