From the popular violin classics of international virtuoso Ishani Bhoola and movie hits of acclaimed mezzo-soprano Alison Hudson, to the traditional Sea Shanties of the Lowestoft Longshoremen there is something for everyone.

In August Simon also presents a nostalgic *Seaside Orchestra* light music programme including the Best of British music with the Festival Trio. A concert packed with familiar melodies.

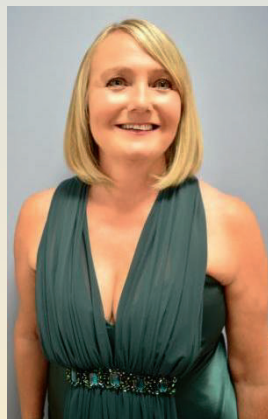
