**Please complete an Electoral Roll form if you haven't already.**

All baptised members of the congregation over the age of 16 are invited to apply to join the roll. Application forms are available in church at the Churchwardens' pew. Please post completed forms through the Bakehouse letterbox or give to one of the Churchwardens.

The Roll will be closed on **19 April** ahead of the APCM. It will then be possible to join after the APCM as usual.

Anyone whose name has been on the electoral roll for a minimum of 6 months can stand for election to the Parochial Church Council (PCC), which, together with the Vicar and Churchwardens, makes decisions about how the church is run. If you are interested in joining the PCC, but have not been on the electoral roll for long enough, it may be possible to become a co-opted member. Please speak to the Churchwardens if you are interested in joining the PCC.

If you would like to make a donation in support of the life and ministry of our church, you can:


- Leave a cash donation in the plate provided
