Ben O'Neill is organizing a "**Songs of Praise**" for Wednesday, 1 May at 18.15 in the church. Songs of Praise is a BBC Television religious programme that presents Christian hymns. We will be accompanied in our singing by the organ. There will also be prayers, but it is not a standard evening service.

On 2 May there will be a **guided walking tour of the Jewish neighbourhood in the 2nd district of Vienna** from 15.00-17.00. Where are the Jewish organisations and institutions? The guided walk ends with a visit to a kosher restaurant for those who want to stay on, where participants can enjoy kosher food.
