The Church has a varied track record when it comes to gender—especially over the last 100 years as women's roles in the home, the church, and society have shifted, and with varied responses. Some cite Paul's exhortations in the New Testament to restrict leadership positions to men. Others cite Lydia as the first European convert and a prominent member of the Philippian church (supporting Paul), not to mention a sense of progress over the last 2,000 years, in order to take a wholly affirming position.
