Dear Friends,

It hardly seems possible that just last Sunday we were worshipping in church, having made some minor adjustments, and now here we are a week later with all church services suspended. The coronavirus pandemic means that we are all having to make enormous adjustments in our daily lives, with many folk self-isolating and practising social distancing. And of course people are feeling anxious and fearful, lonely and disconnected from their social groups as activities and meetings are cancelled.

One response to this kind of fear can be seen in the panic buying which has taken hold and is causing mayhem. Another response is to offer help and support and I am happy to report that the latter is what is happening in our parishes.

In **Derry Hill and Studley** a Community Support initiative has been set up. There are four co-ordinators who can be contacted by telephone or email by folk who need help or support — with shopping, collecting prescriptions, a chat, signposting to further assistance or advice, prayer requests etc. The co-ordinators cascade these requests to a bank of volunteers who carry out the required task. Currently there are 17 volunteers. Leaflets have been delivered and an article will appear in the April magazine.
