Letter from the Vicarage

Dear friends,

Zara and I are reading a book called "The ruthless elimination of hurry" by John Mark Comer. It's a challenging book about how the fast pace of life doesn't do any of us any good and how looking at the slow paced life of Jesus will help us.

If you are anything like me, my to-do list is never ending and I often feel like I am chasing my tail. Lent, the season we find ourselves in before Easter, is a time to stop, pause and prepare. Advent is meant to be the same, yet December seems to be this frantically busy month. 'We are not called to be busy, we are called to be fruitful'.



Can I invite you to join me, in stopping and being

still for 5 minutes each day? Some of you will be able to do longer, for some of you 5 minutes will feel really tricky. As we stop, let's pause and think of Easter. Allow God to speak. You might need a pen and paper to jot down anything he says - or if you're like me, to add to the list of things to do, those extra jobs that we're reminded of!

Let's think about how Jesus came and walked the earth, he didn't drive or fly and yet he had such a profound impact. Let's marvel at how he loves us and left the wonders of heaven for us and for our community. And as we focus on the passion story, the narrative that leads us towards Easter, reflect on the significance of that suffering, punishment and death that he went through for each of us.

I believe God will speak as we pause and he will equip us for all we have to do. I look forward to hearing stories of what Jesus has said to you.
