Opening Praise:

Sunday Morning

“The Lord has risen indeed” (Luke 24:34)

Monday Morning

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. And God said, “Let there be light”, and there was light. (Genesis 1:1-3)

Tuesday Morning

Let me hear in the morning of your steadfast love, for in you I trust. Make me know the way I should go, for to you I lift up my soul. (Psalm 143:8)

Wednesday Morning

The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. (Lamentations 3:22-23)

Thursday Morning

Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you (Isaiah 60:1)

Friday Morning

And he said to him, “Rise and go your way; your faith has made you well.” (Luke 17:19)

Saturday Morning

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. (John 13:34)

O Lord, open our lips;
and our mouth shall proclaim your praise.
Grant your Holy Spirit illuminate our minds,
and, lead us into all truth, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

Confession:

Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love. For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me. Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit. (Psalm 51:1,3,12)

Or the ‘Jesus Prayer’:

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner.

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. (1 Peter 1:3-5)

(Do not be afraid to name some!)

Reign in me Holy Spirit/Lord
*(Pray to be filled with the Holy Spirit and for transformation of the heart toward
holiness)*

Use me Lord
(Ask that the Lord would give opportunities to serve him and others)

Strengthen me Lord/Holy Spirit
(Pray for strengthening of faith; courage; strength in trying times etc.)

Teach me your ways, O Lord
*(Pray to learn wisdom , how to love as we should and anything else that will
build love and service for God and our neighbour)*
