

Stations of the Resurrection Project

As a way of prayerfully marking the re-opening of our churches when that comes, I would like us to create for our churches a series of “Stations of the Resurrection”. I invite you to bring your own interests and skills to this – you might be inspired to create artwork or prayers or written reflections that tell the story of one or more of the stations; you might find experiences, photos, newspaper cuttings, craft activities that have a connection with one of them, but also remind you of times of grace in this year’s Easter-tide.

I invite you to spend some time reflecting on each of the resurrection appearances of Jesus in the stories listed below. If one captures your interest or imagination in particular, stay with it. What is it expressing for you as you read it at this time? How might you connect that with what is going on in your life, or the wider world now? Can you capture those thoughts and reflections artistically, through the written word, with a particular object or image that you find?

If you can gather whatever inspires you and keep it readiness for us forming a display together in church at the end of the restrictions that would be great. If you want to be in touch about this “project” in the meantime with questions or ideas, do get in contact.

I have added a final station which allows for any moment you want to capture which is just about recognising resurrection life now.

The disciples on the road to Emmaus noticed “were not our hearts burning within us while he was talking to us on the road” when they realised they had met the risen Jesus.

May we notice those moments when our hearts show us something of Jesus’ risen presence with us, and may we find ways to celebrate and record these moments to share when we again come together and like them know him in the breaking of the bread. Amen.
