In the parish of Keyworth

NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

- 1 Provide a new glazed, timber door to replace the existing South door, to rehang the door on the other side and to reposition the existing Holy Water Stoup to the West side of the door.
- 2 Carefully remove the existing oak door from site and carefully remove the current thin lining fixed to the stone
- 3 To source seasoned English Oak and manufacture the glazed door as detailed on the drawing; Plug screw and pellet the new frame into the stone allowing for 8nr. fixings. Allow for the inclusion of 1.5 pairs of 100mm grade 13 stainless bronze hinges for the frame
- 4 Incorporate Samuel Heath Perko Powermatic concealed door closer; Incorporate 8mm toughened glass with sadolin driglaze or 15mm x 3mm security glazing tape into the prepared recesses in the frame
- 5 Fix the oak internal beads with bronze cup and screws; Allow for 3 coats of Danish Oil to all oak surface
- 6 To carefully cut out and remove the existing holy water stoup and carefully cut out and place in the new position on the right hand side of the inside of the door. Allow for a stone inset to match the existing stone as repair following the removal of the stoup. Allow for carefully repairing holes following the removal of the door lining
- 7 All in accordance with Specification dated April 2020 and drawing AP01 PR135 dated April 2020 by Mr G Renton, Church Architect
