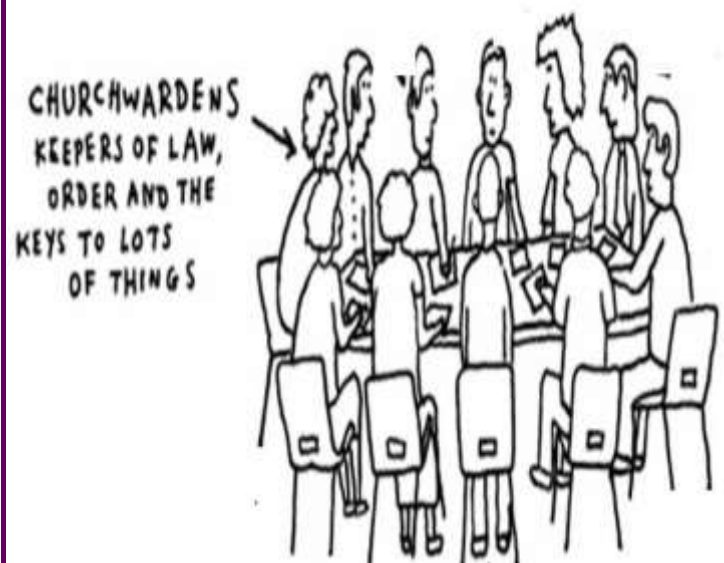
At the APM on Wednesday 26th May three Church Wardens were elected:
