Helping to get the bells ringing in Bawtry again!!

St Nicholas PCC are delighted to report that we finally have the required permissions to progress the structural repairs required to St Nicholas bell tower. The cost of the repair is expected to be around £68,000.

As a PCC we have around £28,000 of funds - leaving us very little in our reserves. We are currently applying for grants from charitable organisations who may or may not provide some of the funding required.

We are hopeful that we can raise some money locally and whilst we are mindful that the last 18 months have been a very difficult time financially for many, we are also hopeful that church members will also feel able to donate generously to this important project. More details on how you can do that are coming soon!

If you have fundraising ideas to help us reach the financial target please contact Becky and we will arrange to meet at the church to get the 'wheels in motion'.

We have been tasked by the diocesan chancellor to complete the work by May 2022, so no time to hang around!! Please pray, please give and please volunteer to help!!
