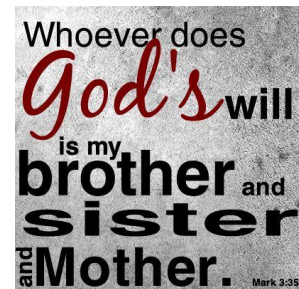

LIVING IN LOVE & FAITH

Living in Love and Faith (LLF) is the national conversation on Christian teaching and learning about identity, sexuality and marriage which is taking place across the Church of England throughout this year.

Its goal is to help all of us to engage and listen well to one another, so that our understanding deepens - both of the questions and of each other.

As part of our engagement with this process of teaching and learning, we will be running the **5 week LLF Course in our Benefice** in the autumn so look out for more details of how you can sign up.

We do not yet know whether we will hold this in person, via zoom or a blend of both! Meanwhile, there is a suite of resources available including a book and a series of podcasts and short films that are all available for free by registering at the LLF Learning Hub online. **This is a big conversation and you are all invited to be a part of it.**
