### **Reduce Your Carbon Footprint**

So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you, for this sums up the Law and the Prophets. Matthew 7:12

Carbon Dioxide emissions are the biggest cause of global heating.

Measuring how much CO2 we produce is a great way to start thinking about how we can do more to care for God's creation and shows us the areas of our life we need to target to make changes if we are going to play our part in preventing our planet heating in a way which will devastate millions of lives.

In Wiltshire 26% of carbon emissions come from our homes. There are simple steps we can take to reduce the amount of carbon dioxide we produce as well as bigger steps such installing insulation, solar panels or new heating systems.

- If you want an estimate based on some easy to answer questions, try https://footprint.wwf.org.uk/.
- If you want to go for detail and accuracy try <a href="https://www.carbonfootprint.com/calculator.aspx">https://www.carbonfootprint.com/calculator.aspx</a>
- Next time you switch your energy provider select an electricity provider using entirely renewable sources of energy (if you haven't switched recently you will probably save money as well!)
- Turning your thermostat down by 1 degree will save you money and reduce the amount of carbon your boiler produces.
