#### A MESSAGE FROM YOUR ECO CHURCH TEAM!

One way to be more ecologically friendly is to reduce your consumption. Think before you buy any product - do you really need it? How did the production of this product impact the environment and what further impacts will there be with the disposal of the product (and associated packaging materials)? When you are thinking about buying something, try the 30-Day Rule -- wait 30 days after the first time you decide you want a product before you buy it. This will eliminate impulse buying.

Or how about observing an Eco-Sabbath: For one day, afternoon or hour a week, don't buy anything, don't use machines, don't switch on anything electric, don't cook, don't answer your phone.

Before the Service speak to God; during the Service let God speak to you, after the Service speak to one another.
