Last week has seen the autumn equinox, that time of year when day and night share roughly equal number of hours. The morning sun is lower, the mornings are cooler and evenings creepingly shorter. The skyscape still has housemartins and bats, with hedgehogs still on the move.

Rushwick as a wider landscape is changing, so if you can't tell an oak leaf from a sycamore (and even if you can) here are some suggestions to help everyone get out and about. There is still much on our doorstep to celebrate and conserve.

Worcestershire Wildlife Trust has many reserves to visit, while Worcestershire County Council offers a range of walks across the county, usefully arranged by length. The Nature Trail at The Fold is not far away and we are surrounded by a maze of footpaths. The RSPB has a good Fun and Learning section for families, whilst Gardener's World offers lots of information on what to do/not do at this time of year to give wildlife a hand. If gardening or walks do not appeal, many conservation charities have volunteering opportunities.
