'HELP REFUGEES AT CHRISTMAS' through One4all gift cards, on Sunday 5th December at both services



Having spoken to Wolverhampton City of Sanctuary we have discovered that the best way we can support refugees in our city this Christmas and be sure that what we give is what is needed, is to buy gift cards which they can then spend on the items they need. So, on **Sunday, 5th December** we invite you to donate either money with which we will buy cards, or you can buy a card yourself (on line or at post offices) and bring it on that Sunday. These will be delivered to refugees by Wolverhampton City of Sanctuary.
