## REVISION OF THE ELECTORAL ROLL 2021

This year we are only required to revise the Electoral Roll. To qualify to be on the Electoral Roll you must be baptized and aged 16 or over and be resident within the parish or if not resident in the parish you must have habitually attended public worship in the parish during a period of at least 6 months prior to enrolment. If you are not already on the Electoral Roll and would like to be, please complete an Electoral Roll form and send it to the Parish Office no later than Friday 6th May 2022. Electoral Roll forms are available from the Parish Office or can be downloaded from the church website. The Roll will be closed from Sunday 24 April until Friday 6 May for preparation and will be available for inspection between Tuesday 10 - Tuesday 24 May 2022.

Church Annual Meeting and APCM at 8.00pm on Tuesday 24th May 2022
At the Annual Meeting of Parishioners at 8.00 pm on 24th May 2022, the election will take place of two Churchwardens to serve for one year.
There will also be elections for the Parochial Church Council (PCC). For the PCC nominees must have been on the Electoral Roll of the Parish for at least six months, must be an actual communicant and be aged 16 years or over. Each nominee must have a proposer and seconder and give consent to the nomination.
