The Friday Art Club

Ecclesiastes 3 v1: "There is a time for everything, and a season for all activity under the heavens."



Rosie Hawley, a friend who attends Dore and Totley Christian Fellowship, and I, run the Friday Art Club. We are trained teachers and have both taught art during the course of our careers. We each, separately, had a vision for a small community art group and had reached the stage in our lives when this idea could come to fruition.

After many months of prayer and reflection and with the support of Christ Church Local Mission Team

the Friday Art Club started on Friday 6th May 2022 at 2pm, in the back room of Christ Church Dore Community Centre. We were a small group, eight in total, just right for our first tentative steps into a new project. Ten months and ten sessions on, we now have 27 members and have moved from the back room into the main hall, something that we did not anticipate would happen so quickly.

It is a joy to see the group grow and to meet people from our local community. Together, we have learned new techniques such as felting, lino printing, origami, colour mixing and pastel drawing. We have learned about the life of Van Gogh and tried to emulate his work. Our friend, Diane Capps has led a session on card making and we have also invited several other makers to share their skills with us.

The sessions are very relaxed and usually begin with a demonstration before moving on to the activity. Tea, coffee and home made cake is available throughout the afternoon and is happily received! We have a display of our work at the end of the session and often people are surprised at their creative ability which had hitherto been hidden.

Our aim is to provide a low key, relaxing art session for members of our local community. Everyone is welcome, whether their objective is to meet new



people, make new friends, pick up new skills or just to sit and have time to be creative away from the distractions of life.

As Christians, Rosie and I are open about our faith. We are happy to pray for people and a prayer box is made available at each session for members to request prayer.

We would encourage all of you who have the seed of a plan to further God's work in our community, to pursue it. He will honour your efforts.

Have you thought of being a member of PCC?

Our church council (PCC stands for Parochial Church Council) consists of 12 elected members and some other co-opted and ex-officio members. We usually have 18 to 20 people who work on the future direction of the church as well as ensuring that we adopt safe and lawful practices. It can be a challenge keeping up with changes in the Law and advice from our diocese. However there is a shared vision of our mission and the decisions made are based in prayer. The PCC meets online for 10 or 11 meetings a year and once, face to face, on a Saturday morning for prayer, worship and strategic planning based on our mission to others. PCC work keeps you on your toes and is an opportunity to see how all aspects of the church's work fit together.

This year we will be looking to elect 2 churchwardens as Alison Saxton and Julia Stevens are stepping back. Alison remains on the leadership team as Treasurer and so is automatically a member of PCC. Some other members of PCC are either up for re-election after a first term of three years or they have served two consecutive three year terms and have to stand down for 12 months.

There will be three vacancies of three years and one casual vacancy of two years when we meet at our annual meeting on **May 16**th **2023**.

If you think it may be what you can contribute to the life of the church you will need to complete a nomination form which will be downloadable from the website or obtained from the Parish Office. If you need to talk it over please speak to Andy Patrick or PCC Secretary,

Gardening help in the churchyard - There are several tasks needed in the churchyard that would require only a couple of hours a month during the summer. It would be really helpful if anyone was able to offer to give that time and take responsibility for one of these. Things like weeding the rose garden, weeding and removal of leaves on a short stretch of border near the church (NOT the whole border, it will be divided into sections), deadheading, feeding and pruning the roses, watering if it is very dry and other similar things. This will not be heavy work like strimming, mowing or cutting back shrubs but much lighter tasks. Anyone involved would need to bring their own garden tools but the green bins are

there for cuttings, weeds etc. This is an opportunity to support the church, outside in the sunshine amid peaceful surroundings at a day and time to suit you. Wonderful!


