Parish Update

It was wonderful to see so many people at the united service at St Gabriel's a couple of weeks ago and very pleasing that so many people were able to stay on for the Parish meeting. Thanks to St Gabriel's for hosting this.

I would like to thank everyone for their honest and perceptive comments, either during the meeting itself or in the Away Day booklets that were given out at the beginning of April.

There is no doubt that these are difficult and upsetting decisions that we are taking. There is, understandably, so much emotion and history tied up with belonging to a Church community - many of us will still be worshipping where our parents and grandparents worshipped before us, and where we have been involved throughout our lifetimes. Each of us would certainly be very upset at the prospect of the Church that we love being closed.

It was clear from the thoughts that have been expressed that this will be a difficult journey. However, following a vote of those present, over 90% agreed that, realistically, we have too many Churches in our Parish and that, as a result of trying to raise funds to sustain and maintain our Churches, together with having insufficient people to take on all the roles that are needed, at least one of our Churches needs to close.

Holy Trinity has now begun its own journey, hopefully to be established as a CIC (Community Interest Company) separate

from the Parish of The Good Shepherd and it will need our prayers as it travels along this challenging route.

The PCC will now work to establish the best criteria for analysing the financial sustainability, maintenance and future for each of our 4 Churches. It will not be a speedy process—we need to be thoroughly fair to every aspect of each of our Churches in order to assess them fairly. As we have already tried to make clear, there is no hidden agenda and the Diocese will have no say until we, the Parish, agree on a final outcome and ask the PCC to inform the Diocese of our decision.

There will undoubtedly be more meetings. There will be fact-finding exercises and the PCC will keep you informed regularly through the whole process.

Please pray for our PCC as they work through this as well as for each congregation and for each of our Churches.
