offer crisis support in Sheffield City Centre, providing hot meals, food parcels, health and hygiene facilities as well as advice and support on many issues to do with homelessness. Whilst all gifts are appreciated, the needs of homeless people can be very specific, for instance a rough sleeper needs food that can be prepared and eaten on the street, often without the luxury of mugs, plates or tin-openers. In this instance pot noodles, cuppa soups and ring pull tins are helpful. Please also note that 25% of clients are rough sleepers. Sleeping bags and blankets are gratefully appreciated.
