A Message From Our Vicar, David

What a year! As we welcome in 2024 and look ahead to all that is before this year come, I pray that we all can remember that no matter how we approach this new year, with all its uncertainties, difficulties, even opportunities and possibilities, that we you can hold on to the one who holds you.

Holding on is a very common theme through music, films, and books. The holding on by our fingertips fearing falling into the void, maybe some of you have felt like that. Just hanging on for the new year.

Let me point you to Psalm 63 as we walk into 2024. David is in the wilderness; Saul is threatening to kill him, he is on his own, hiding. He has left behind him everything. David is in hiding in the desert, but just look at his response, there is no sinking into self-pity, or breathing blue murderous threats against those after him, there's no blaming of friends for abandoning him, or even against God who it must have felt had left him. In that moment David chooses not to push God away but to draw him in even closer, he chooses to hold on even more tightly. David thinks of the good times with God, seeing God in the temple, beholding his power and glory, enjoying his love. He remembers who God is and what he has done. Here in the desert place, David is bringing God into his desert place. He is trusting God for the future.

I do not know what this coming year has for you, or for me. But I do know that the God who was there in the past, is the God who will be with you in the future. That the God who was loving and faithful in the past, is the God who was the same yesterday, today and forever, and will be loving and faithful and good in the future.

Rather than letting go, I want to encourage you to hold on tighter.

So this year let us hold on tightly to God, let us hold on tightly to the one who loves us so much that he would come to be with and give himself for us. Whatever this year has for us let us cling to the Lord.
