## REFLECTIONS......MARK BICK Reflection 18th Feb 2024

## Mark 19-15

Jesus Baptised by John.

Our Gospel reading is about Jesus coming to John to be baptised. This is a clear act of humility, an identification with us all - ordinary people, who mess up in life, need to ask for forgiveness, and change direction. It marks the start of Jesus's ministry with God's Holy Spirit filling him with the power he needed to fulfil his calling

We are also invited by Jesus to join this journey of faith, to repent and become disciples. I was baptised in this parish, as an infant, 62 years ago.

#### CONTINUED ....

My parent's prayer and nurturing of my faith played a big part followed by faltering steps as a teenager to explore that faith more independently. I had contact with lots of Christians who knew very definitely the date on which they became a Christian and spent a few years worrying that I did not have that certainty. I eventually realised that it is was my relationship with Jesus each day that matters. It is a journey where we never arrive, but are always drawn on by God's spirit to grow and mature. The biblical accounts make it very clear that each individual's journey can happen in very different ways, it can be dramatic, can be stop-start, or gradual and steady. We just need to start (or re-start) and keep going!
