



From the vicar

Welcome to St Nicholas. I'm writing this in late February. It feels like Spring is almost upon us. The sun is shining. There are daffodil shoots in the churchyard. By the time you read this, they may even be flowering!

In this part of the world, Spring is a season of new life and hope – more daylight, colourful flowers, chicks and lambs. For many of us, that in itself is a reason to be thankful. But Christians have a much greater reason to be thankful at this time of year as Easter is approaching.

On Good Friday we remember Jesus' sacrificial death: 'Christ suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteousness, to bring you to God.' (1 Peter chapter 3 verse 18). This was the ultimate act of love as Jesus gave up his life for the sins of the world. That morning, I encourage you to join the Good Friday Walk of Witness (details opposite). Our church will be open 1pm-3pm offering a quiet place to pray and reflect.

On Easter Sunday morning, we will celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. In his book 'Surprised by Hope', Tom Wright describes the resurrection as <u>the</u> pivotal moment in history, when God's new creation began. The good news is that we can each be part of it, through faith in the risen Christ and the gift of God's Holy Spirit. And we can look forward with hope to the time when God will make all things new. Revelations chapter 21 verse 5: 'He who was seated on the throne said, "I am making everything new!" (Revelation chapter 21 verse 5). Let's pray for more of God's new creation in our lives, church and world.
