A Message From Our Vicar, David

February- a month which, according to Asda, Hallmark, and Amazon, is fully take up with all things pink and flowery. On the 14<sup>th</sup> of this month there'll be overpriced flowers and cards for sale at every shop, cheesy poems, and chocolatey goodies, all in the name of love and romance.

History suggests that St Valentine was priest who, despite being told by the authorities that married men made useless soldiers and therefore weddings were illegal, secretly offered wedding services to young couples looking to wed. Bishop Valentine maintained that marriage was part of God's plan and purpose for the world, and he went against Emperor Claudius who decreed that these young weddings were forbidden. His success led to unwelcome notoriety. He was jailed and ultimately beheaded, but not before he fell in love with the jailer's daughter. It is thought that on the evening of his execution the bishop passed her a note which read "from your Valentine".

Of course, the message of the Christian faith is that love wins. We look to Jesus, the one who is fully God and fully man, the one who is love, holiness and goodnessand we see a love that sent him to the cross.
