#### **ELECTORAL ROLL**

This is an advance notice that the electoral roll is due for revision commencing 31 March 2024. Persons listed on the electoral roll are eligible to vote at the annual church meetings and it also provides an opportunity to register your involvement with the St Paul's church family.

People already on the electoral roll are invited to view the electoral roll for details and to amend accordingly. Additions to the roll can be people who live in the parish aged 16 and over who declare that they are a member of the Church of England, or of a church in communion with it. People who live outside the parish can discuss their request with the Electoral Roll Officer.

The 'Notice of Preparation' will be displayed in the church foyer along with the 'Electoral Privacy Notice' outlining the details regarding personal data. The print copy of the electoral roll will be available to view in the Brindle room and forms for enrolment will be available from Sunday 31 March.
