REFLECTIONS......REV. BEA ERSKINE

It is Palm Sunday and we have the Passion readings where the narrative really begins to speed up, hurtling inexorably towards the crucifixion. Although our attention may be drawn towards Jesus' death upon the cross, the gospel passages are packed full of so many instances of very human responses to what is going on around in the bigger story.

For example, the woman pouring the expensive nard over Jesus's head, how did she know? The fury of those around at the waste of this. Judas Iscariot betraying Jesus, tempted by money. The disciples vehemently agreeing with Peter that they would not deny Jesus. The human condition is played out in full in so many responses, throughout the Passion story.

It is easy to think that the disciples should have believed and understood what Jesus was telling them, after all they had been with him through his ministry, heard his preaching, seen his miracles, surely, they had all the evidence they needed? But no, instead you can almost feel their panic at everything unravelling around them,

The Messiah is not meant to die in this way. Palm Sunday invites us all, not only to walk with Jesus and the disciples towards the crucifixion, but also to take a moment to reflect upon what our own response might be had we too been witnesses to this earth-shattering moment in time.


