This Holy Week, I have been in and out of school at both St John the Baptist and at St Andrews. I have shared the Easter story with Nursery, Reception and Year I through Godly Play. I have been stunned by the amazing Year 3–4 and 4–5 Easter plays, with the children acting and singing the story of Jesus's death and resurrection. And I have led the Holy Week services for both schools in the churches. It's been a busy week!

Much of this work is hidden from the congregations at our churches and, as a result, it can feel like we are not passing on the story of Jesus to the next generation. So it's good to share with you that as a collective worship team, we are sharing the story of God's love with over 400 children every week. We know they hear it and that the seeds of the Gospel are sown, and we trust God with their germination!

As we come to the beginning of the Easter holidays, we are also preparing for another three sessions of Make Lunch. It has been a year since we started opening our doors to families in need of food; which can be both physical and spiritual. We shared some of our stories of the last year with our Transforming Lives for Good (TLG) Lead, Alex Hall, who has supported us on the journey and led our yearly review. She is so pleased with our work that she has awarded us Gold Club status! Thank you to all of our team and our supporters for your amazing work!

Sometimes we don't see the fruits of our labour for God, but this week I also got a general message from a Prison Chaplain thanking everyone who works in schools and churches sharing God's love. She spoke about the seeds of God's love coming to fruit in the complicated and difficult lives of the women she cares for. The memories of worship and welcome from God's family help bring people in the darkest places back to God. God who loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that whoever believes in him would not perish, but have everlasting life! Alleluia!

Jesus is alive you know! He's risen from the dead!
