FRESHWATER PARISH HALL – an update on the Parish Hall Project



In addition to some general maintenance, installation of replacement doors (courtesy of the Freshwater Parish Council) and lots of ground clearance and clearing of cupboards, we are pleased to report that an asbestos survey has been carried out (and report received) and also a structural survey has been completed of the stage roof and the back wall, which needs urgent repair work.

We have local architect Warren Whyte on board and with his help we are working through a clear process which sets out, step by step, how best to proceed with this challenging project.

A small subgroup group has been formed who are tasked with looking at marketing and funding and we are grateful that members of the community have come forward to offer their services.

We are currently producing a floor plan and looking at how best to include a new kitchen layout, lobby and toilet area - ensuring that we take account of things such as accessibility for all. When this is agreed by the project group, it will go before the Parochial Church Council for ratification and then on to the architect for his input and a full design based on our wishes.

This is a big project and each stage takes time, but to get it done properly we need to be mindful to get things right.

Next steps ... the structural survey has highlighted some work to stone walls and stage roof which will need doing asap. We will need to fund raise to pay for this as our 'project pot' has dropped to zero! We very much hope that our new group will be able to make a good start on a marketing campaign and to begin in earnest with fundraising.

We still need startup funds and we welcome all offers of help with fundraising and/or donations. Keep an eye out for fundraising events which include – coming up soon - A JUMBLE SALE ON SATURDAY 2nd March @ 9am. And a RACE NIGHT WITH THE BAY WAILERS on Saturday 23rd March @ 7 pm. And also keep an eye out for our Go Fund Me page and an increased social media presence.
